The compound is neutral overall, but consists of positively charged ions called cations and negatively charged ions called anions. In chemistry, an ester is a chemical compound derived from an acid (organic or inorganic) in which at least one $-OH$ (hydroxyl) group is replaced by an $-O$ -alkyl group.
