George MacDonald (10 December 1824 – 18 September 1905) was a Scottish author, poet and Christian minister. He was a pioneering figure in the field of fantasy literature and the mentor of fellow writer Lewis Carroll. Booking for our conference in Cambridge this coming July has now gone live on the Society's web site. The Theme is George MacDonald and the Cambridge Apostles, which is very appropriate, since Trinity Hall was the college of F.D. Maurice, MacDonald's mentor. Lilith is a fantasy novel by Scottish writer George MacDonald and first published in 1895. Its importance was recognized in its later revival in paperback by Ballantine Books as the fifth volume of the Ballantine Adult Fantasy series in September 1969.
