In the field of management, strategic management involves the formulation and implementation of the major goals and initiatives taken by an organization's top management on behalf of owners, based on consideration of resources and an assessment of the internal and external environments in which the organization operates. The word 'dynamics' appears frequently in discussions and writing about strategy, and is used in two distinct, though equally important senses.
